

18th Annual Inland Empire 3-Gun Championship

The 2010 Inland Empire 3 Gun Championship Match is limited to the first 70 entries. The dates are September 25th and 26th with 7 challenging multi-gun stages and a totally new stage Sunday for a Team Man on Man shoot while stats are completed.

The COF's will not be published on the website nor before the match. The cost is \$100 if postmarked before September 1st, and \$125 if postmarked on or after September 1st. Lunch will be provided on both days.

DIVISIONS

Limited (iron sights only)

Tactical (single optic on rifle)

Heavy Metal (.308 rifle/pump shotgun/8 round .45)

Open (almost anything goes)

RULES

Most of the rules will be governed by the Tri-Gun Challenge Rules that can be viewed at www.trigunchallenge.com. This site also better explains the division equipment rules. If you are uncertain, contact the Match Director, Bill Sahlberg, at thesahlberg7@webtv.net for any clarifications before the match.

SCORING

The Hoerner Method COF scoring will be 'neutralized targets'. This is any paper hit with two shots. C hits will add 1/2 second and D hits on paper will add 1-1/2 second per hit on paper. This is called TIME PLUS scoring which is your actual time plus the penalties that are added onto your time: misses, procedurals, no shoots, and failure to engage will add 5 seconds.

Our Match Sponsor again is DPMS. All prizes are all given away by random raffle drawing but the awards are given away by match placement. Several prizes will be designated prizes by the contributors: ie. 'Crease Award'.

ROUND COUNT

Rifle will be from 10 to 300 yards: bring 150+ rounds. Shotgun will be against static and moving targets but no flying birds: bring 125+ shot shells (#6 to #8, no 00 buck) and 10 slugs. Pistol will be 100+ rounds. Some stages will have a maximum time limit to keep the shooting schedule on time.

SUNDAY TEAM SHOOTOFFS

You will want to get three people together, one must be a 'novice' shooter. Bring extra ammo for your 3 Gun Man on Man Team Shoot, Sunday on the rifle line. Each 3 man team will be able to shoot the COF to qualify and top 3 teams will get a plaque.
