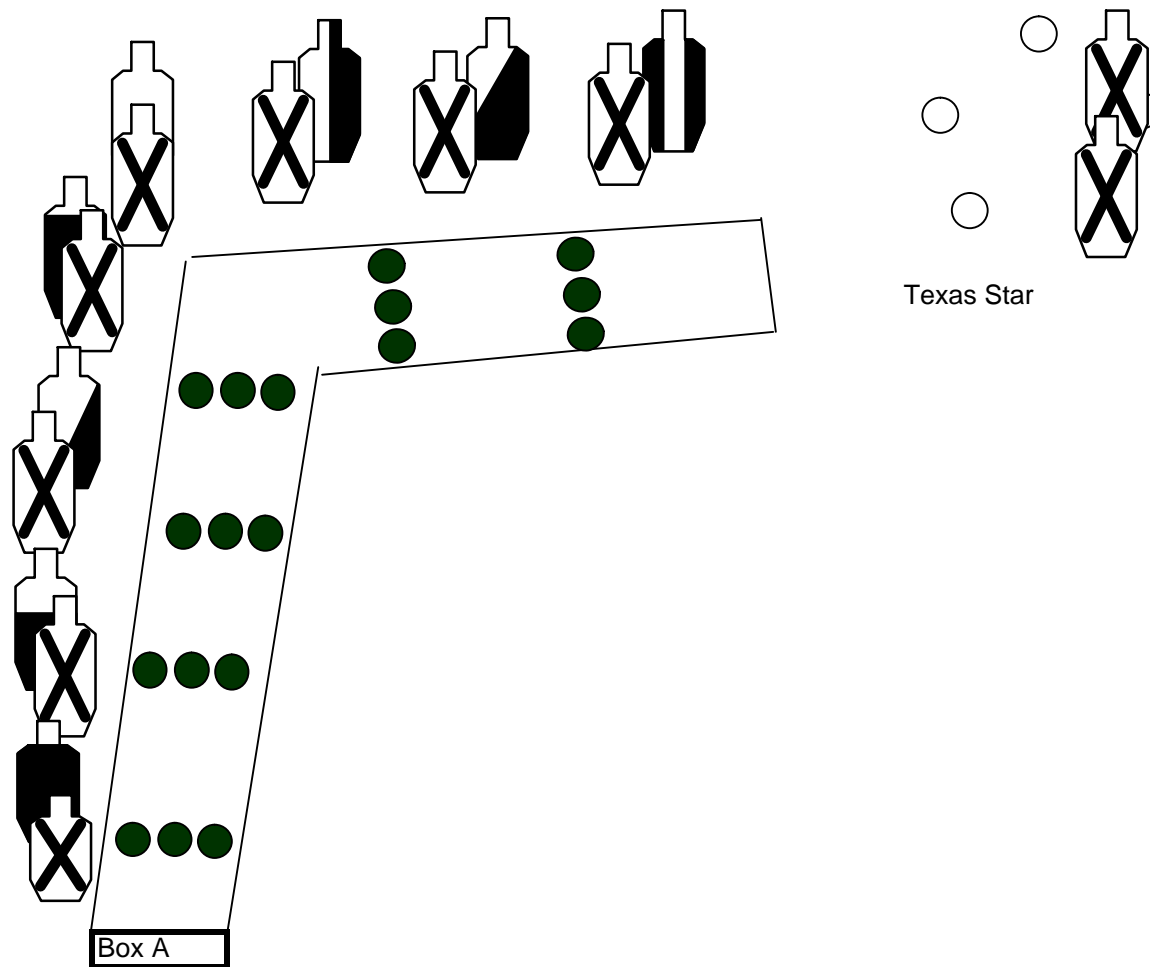


# Speed Bumps

**RULES:** Practical Shooting Handbook, Latest Edition

**COURSE DESIGNER:** Mark O'Shea



<b>START POSITION: Standing in Box A facing down range hands at sides</b>	
<p><b>STAGE PROCEDURE</b></p> <p>At start signal proceed down range engaging targets as they become visible from behind fault lines. Be careful of the speed bumps. One procedural for each row of speed bumps with any broken bumps.</p>	<p><b>SCORING</b></p> <p><b>Scoring:</b> Comstock, 21 rds, 85 points</p> <p><b>Targets:</b> 8 IPSC, 5 Steel</p> <p><b>Scored Hits:</b> Best 2 per IPSC steel must fall</p> <p><b>Start-Stop:</b> Audible - Last Shot</p> <p><b>Penalties:</b> Procedural -10 No Shoot -10 Miss -10</p>

**Set up notes:** The speed bumps are rows of clay birds. The no shoots should be positioned so that each target can only be seen by moving forward from the last one. Texas star should have the right two targets blocked by no-shoots.
